THE TERM AHEAD – TERM 2 2023

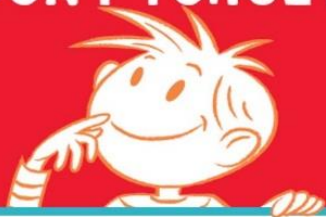

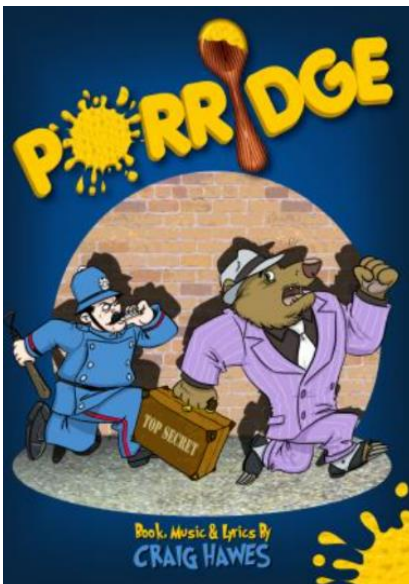

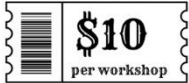
