STREET CHANGES

I would like to sincerely thank our whānau and community for abiding by our new street/roading conditions/layout around the school. The aim of these is to improve the safety for pedestrians and our school children. As parents will know this is for a year's trial and at the end of the trial period the TDC will determine what the permanent outcome will be. I have fielded a number of comments and so has the TDC. We are very happy to hear what people think. Some modifications have already been made and I'm sure there will be others.

One thing that the TDC consultants (they are often here checking developments) and us have noticed has been an increase in the number of parents parking on yellow lines (to drop children off or pick them up). Please don't do this – it is illegal to do so. The local parking warden will be giving out tickets to those doing so. Of greater concern is the fact there are good reasons for the yellow lines being there – so vehicles don't obstruct the visibility of others in the area and also people stopping on yellow lines can hold up the flow of traffic. The safety of our children is paramount. Many thanks.

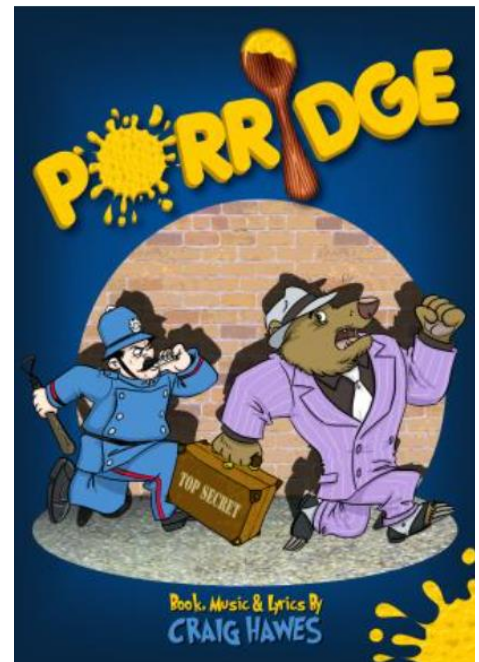
