### OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENT APPLICATIONS

The Richmond School Board of Trustees invites applications from parents who wish to enrol their children at Richmond School during 2024.

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office.

Families who wish to apply should do so in writing addressed to Tim Brenton (Principal) stating your child's name, date of birth and current address. The deadline for receipt of applications for out-of-zone places is Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2023.

The Board has determined that 25 places are likely to be available throughout the year groups.

Parents of students (yet to be enrolled) who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan for the remainder of 2023 and the 2024 school year.

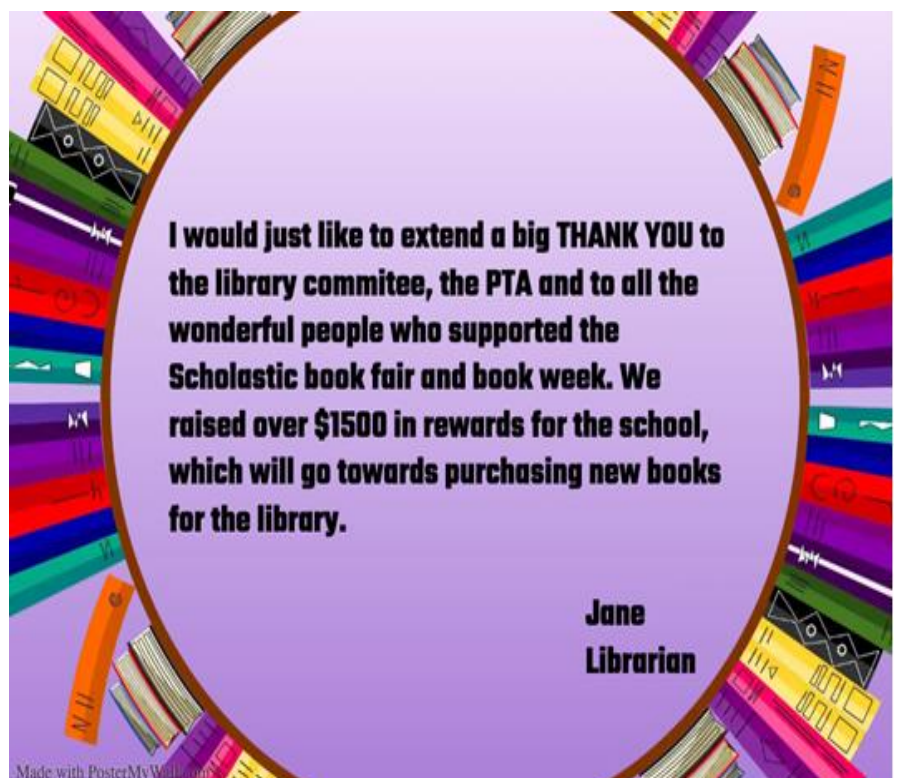
The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot.

If a ballot is required, it will be held on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023.

Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.
