2 reminders:


- 1. If you have someone else (other than who does usually) picking your child up after school, please let your child's teacher know who that person is and even better introduce them to your child's class teacher.

Yesterday we held a mihi whakatau to welcome new staff members, children and families/whānau. As usual it was a wonderful occasion and a very special way to welcome new people into the Richmond School whānau. One of the reasons for holding the Mihi Whakatau is to foster a sense of kotahitanga (unity) and belonging for the entire school.

Each year we have 70-80 new 5-year-olds enrol at the school. There are usually 40-50 other new enrolments during the year and a number of new staff members as well. So, there are certainly a lot of newbies each year. It is fantastic way to acknowledge the arrival of new pupils, staff and whānau and their inclusion at Richmond School.
