#### **OUR SCHOOL BOARD**

The parent representatives are **Paul Suisted**, **Tina Harper**, **Vanessa Jones**, **Bryan Llewellin and Christine Irvine**. **Sue Russ** (elected last year) is the staff representative. As the principal, I am also a board member with full board members rights (a little different to say the CEO's role of company).

Most of the parent members have been on the Board for many years. Paul began on the Board on 14<sup>th</sup> June 2019, Tina started on 9<sup>th</sup> December 2020, Christine since 29<sup>th</sup> September 2022 and Bryan and Vanessa began on 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2023. Vanessa and Christine are also chairpersons of the Parent-Teacher Committee, along with Amy Henley. At our latest Board meeting on the 26<sup>th</sup> February 2025, Paul Suisted was re-elected as the Board Chairperson (now known as the 'Presiding Member'). Paul has been in this role since 17<sup>th</sup> February 2021 and is an outstanding Presiding Member.

The Board members combine to form a very professional group, who govern the school extremely well and ensure the school is functioning as well as possible. The members are very knowledgeable about their role. The Board deals with the 'governance' (setting policies and ratifying documentation/happenings once assured they are completed) of the school whereas management (day-to-day running of the school) is the domain of the school's management team.

What also impresses me about the Richmond School Board, is their focus on making sure things just get better and better – the promotion of continuous improvement.
